

Anderson County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- Anderson County has a population of 204,052.
- There are 29,358 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 14.4% of the population.
- There are 3,964 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 10.8% of the older adult population.
- There are 9,922 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 21.3% of the child population.

Anderson County Distribution

In 2024-2025, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 2.9 million pounds to agencies in Anderson County.

Anderson County Partners

The Food Bank supports 73 programs in Anderson County including Tabernacle of Faith, Good Neighbor Cupboard, IVA First Baptist, Overcomers Outreach, and Honea Path United Ministries.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank works with United Way of Anderson County to help provide backpacks to school districts throughout the county.

The Food Bank operates a branch in Anderson County. This branch also serves Abbeville, Greenwood, Oconee, and Pickens Counties.
