

Pickens County, SC *Facts* at a glance



- Pickens County has a population of 124,590.
- There are 21,473 individuals living at or below the poverty level. This represents 17.2% of the population.
- There are 2,012 individuals 65 years and older living at or below the poverty level. This represents 9.1% of the older adult population.
- There are 3,824 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 15.6% of the child population.

Pickens County Distribution

In 2024-2025, the Food Bank distributed over 88 million pounds of food and household items throughout our 24 county service region.

In the past year, the Food Bank distributed over 2.5 million pounds to agencies in Pickens County.

Pickens County Partners

The Food Bank supports 35 programs in Pickens County including Gleaning House, Pickens Adventist, New Hope Baptist, The Storehouse, and Littlejohn Community Center.

Child Hunger Programs

The Food Bank supports Backpack Programs for elementary, middle and high school students throughout Pickens County.
